- 1. Complete the attached Nomination Form
- 2. Attach three signed letters of nomination detailing why you feel your school deserves to receive the IE Award. Reflect on inclusion in either your school as a whole or on the actions of specific people within the school that has made it a diverse and welcoming place to learn.

Each letter should be a minimum of one to a maximum of two typed pages.

Each school is also encouraged to submit supporting photographic documentation, with pertinent captions, to bring the total submission to a maximum of 8 pages.

Nomination Letters should come from **three** of the following:
