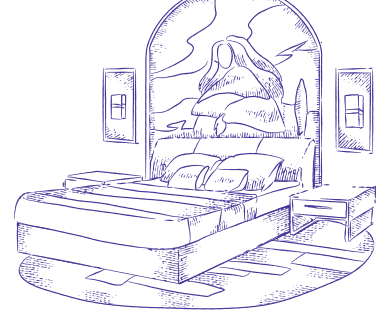


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Explore the HOTEL RESPITE PROGRAM



Inclusion Canada Newfoundland and Labrador is a non-profit organization that works with and on behalf of persons with intellectual disabilities in Newfoundland and Labrador. We are committed to creating awareness about the importance of our the initiatives to the lives of the 15,000 individuals with intellectual disabilities as well as their families and communities.

How It Works:

ICNL has different rate agreements with 12 hotels across the province. Through our Hotel Respite Program, our members can get discounts on rooms at these hotels.

To be eligible for this program, you should be a current member of Inclusion Canada Newfoundland and Labrador. Membership forms are available online at www.inclusioncanadanl.ca.

- You cannot make reservations directly at the hotel by contacting their staff or calling their tollfree number. You must contact Inclusion Canada Newfoundland and Labrador to get the special rate
- You should make reservations through our office minimum of 2 weeks in advance of your desired dates to ensure availability.
- Although we will do our best to get the dates you are looking for, sometimes, due to availability at the hotel, we may need to consider alternate dates
- After Inclusion Canada Newfoundland and Labrador has made your reservation, you can reach out to the hotel directly for any changes.
